Using Markdown

In Pulse, you can use Markdown to write content in pages, blocks or the blog. Anything you type in Markdown format will automatically be converted to HTML on the fly when the content is viewed on the frontend. If you want to use Markdown in blocks and blog pages you should first disable the WYSIWYG editor in config.php.

```
$wysiwyg = false;
```

What is it and why should I use it?

Markdown is a text-to-HTML conversion tool for web writers. Markdown allows you to write using an easy-to-read, easy-to-write plain text format, then convert it to structurally valid XHTML (or HTML).

So basically, you get the power of a WYSIWYG without the clunky toolbar and messy code. You just need to learn a few syntax basics and you're ready to start using Markdown. It's mostly just plain text with a few special formatting styles. For example, to create a header and some body text, you would just write:

```
# My Section Title
This is some paragraph content.
```

This would be automatically converted to:

```
<h1>My Section Title</h1>
This is some paragraph content.
```

Let's run through some more examples of Markdown fun.

When typing in normal paragraph text, Pulse automatically creates line breaks and paragraphs.

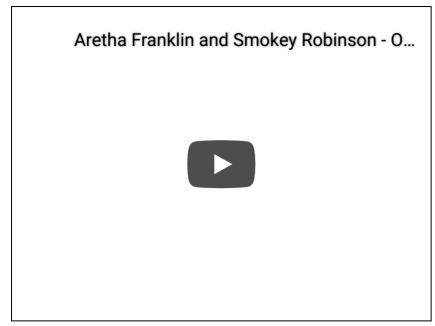
